Moldova Update 2010

We would like to share with you that the ministry we started in 2009 is continuing and growing even though we did not send a team this summer. Last summer we sent two teams to help two church planters start VBS programs in their villages.



The church in the village of Pugoi held its programs for 5 groups of children, despite the obstacles from some village leaders. All in all 77 children were able to participate in the program. At the end invitations were given to parents to attend the final celebration of the week and many responded. Even the Mayor came and in many kind words expressed his support and appreciation for this kind of ministry and promised to support these efforts even in the future. He said: "This is the only group that is doing something for the good of the village. You can count on our support." But there is great opposition also from the local orthodox priest and school principals to mention just a few. Please continue to pray for Pastor Vanya and the small church in Pugoi. Pray that many will continue to attend Sunday school classes and church during the year. The church in Pugoi is very grateful for the support they have received: program help, crafts, game supplies and some finances to provide lunch for the children during the summer.



The same can be said about the Capital of Gagauzia, Komrat, where 96 children were involved in this summer program event. With great joy and zeal the children played, learned about God, competed and retold the stories they have learned to their parents. Many needy families received clothes, blankets and care packages. After the summer camps they continue now to meet with the children twice a week for Bible studies and games and we hope and pray that the children will continue to grow and mature in Christ.



In both villages two-day winter camps were held last year to stay in touch with the children and to reach those who cannot attend regularly the church during the school year and they are planning to do the same this winter. Please pray for the seeds that have been sown this summer.

Thank you dear friends for your help and support. Assisting and empowering the nationals in their Efforts, we can achieve much more for his Kingdom.

We are planning to grow and expand this important ministry to help the church planters in small towns and villages to reach many more children during next summer in Moldova, Armenia and beyond. We would like to send a few teams to help next summer and if you are interested please let us know.
